# **AUDITION SCENES / MONOLOGUES**

### SCENE 1

GASTON Hello... Belle.

**BELLE** Bonjour, Gaston. (GASTON blocks BELLE's way.) Excuse me. (GASTON snatches BELLE's book.) Gaston. May I have my book, please?

**GASTON** (flipping through the book) How can you read this? There's no pictures.

**BELLE** Well some people use their imagination!

**GASTON** Belle, it's about time you got your head out of these books and paid attention to more important things. (GASTON strikes a handsome pose.)

**LEFOU** Hint... hint.

**BELLE** Like you? Gaston, please! I have to get inside to help my father.

**LEFOU** That crazy old fool. He needs all the help he can get! (GASTON and LEFOU laugh heartily.)

**BELLE** Don't talk about my father that way!

**GASTON** (GASTON thunks LEFOU on the head.) Yeah! Don't talk about her father that way!

**BELLE** My father's not crazy! He's a genius!

#### **SCENE 2**

MRS. POTTS We must try to be patient Lumiere. The girl has lost her father and her freedom all in one day.

**LUMIERE** I wonder if the Master has thought that perhaps this girl could be the one to break the spell?

**COGSWORTH** Of course, he has! He's not a fool.

**LUMIERE** Good! So... he falls in love with her, she falls in love with him and poof! We'll be human again by midnight!

MRS. POTTS Lumiere, it's not that easy. These things take time.

LUMIERE But we don't have time! Those rose has already begun to wilt! And he's so....

MRS. POTTS The Master must help her to see past all that.

**COGSWORTH** Well, he could start by trying to make himself more presentable.

**LUMIERE** Impress her with his rapier wit. MRS. POTTS But be gentle.

**COGSWORTH** Shower her with compliments.

**MRS. POTTS** But be sincere.

LUMIERE And above all...

**LUMIERE, COGSWORTH, MRS. POTTS** He must control his temper!
